



## SURF LIFE SAVING SA NO SMOKING POLICY

The current “no smoking” policy adopted at the 21<sup>st</sup> September 1996 State Council meeting is:

*That there be a **NO SMOKING** rule applied in the carnival arena at all SLSSA carnivals. Further, all Clubs should be encouraged to implement the no smoking policy within the confines of their own clubrooms.*

The 23<sup>rd</sup> September 1997 State Council meeting resolved:

*That a smoke free policy be implemented for all indoor environs of properties owned and maintained by SLSSA. Further, that the policy include all activities associated with life saving patrols – and patrolling members, whilst undertaking Club and/or State patrolling duties, shall at all times adhere to the policy.*

A recent call to SLSSA queried whether the “carnival arena” included the designated Club tent area at junior carnivals and after discussion the Board of Management strengthened the current resolution by including the following:

**AT ALL SURF SPORTS EVENTS ALL CLUB TENTS ARE CONSIDERED TO BE PART OF THE CARNIVAL ARENA AND AS SUCH MUST BE SMOKE FREE IN ACCORDANCE WITH OUR CURRENT POLICY.**

It is expected that this policy will be self regulated by Clubs.
