Freddie Green



Freddie Green died in September 2019 on his 91st birthday after having lost all of his family over the years. Geoff his son at the age of 42, heart attack, Julie his daughter, cancer and Audrey his wife, parkinsons.

Freddie was a hero of the Club and swept the Junior boat crew to a State Title in 1959. He swept the Senior crew to many wins during his time at West Beach.

He contributed much to surf lifesaving in South Australia especially in the surf boat arena and worked with boat builders on improving designs. He invented the sloping seat and experimented with oar blades that were very deep in shape and caught so much water one had to be superman to row effectively.

He was invited to South Africa where he was assigned to supervise the building of their first surf boat and then to teach surf life savers how to row.

He is a life member of West Beach and was inducted into the South Australian Hall of Fame in 2018. The photo of Fred was taken at that ceremony.

Dennis Conlon OAM



Dennis Conlin went to that big surf beach in the sky on the 2nd of September 2020 aged 82 years.

Dennis was a foundation member of the West Beach Surf Life Saving Club and a member of the first bronze squad conducted on the 2nd of March 1957. His SA Bronze No. is 115 and he is a life member of West Beach.

Dennis was a boatie and rowed with the Senior "A" crew under Freddie Green. This crew was selected to represent South Australia at the first Australian Championships held in South Australia at Moana Beach in 1962.

Dennis was Secretary of our club for five years and was awarded his Board of Examiners Certificate in 1960, holding the position of District Supervisor and was an official at State and Australian Championships.

Dennis held the position of Secretary of Surf Life Saving South Australia for fourteen years, and then as President for five years. Because of his service to Surf Life Saving Dennis was rewarded with Life Membership of SLSSA in 1979, and an OAM (medal of the Order of Australia) in 1988.

He was inducted into the South Australian Surf Life Saving Hall of Fame in 2018 with his old sweep, Fred Green.

Dennis will be remembered not only as a benevolent dictator (his words) but as a man who gave so much to what we all love, Surf Life Saving.

President's Report

The 2019-2020 Season will be remembered in one word - COVID. This pandemic saw the closure of international and state borders with whole countries going into lock-down. This resulted in an abrupt end to the season for us with State Championships and National Championships cancelled.

It is a credit to the resilience of our Club and competitors that they responded accordingly and respectfully to the tough decisions being made at all levels of the association and government.

It's hard to believe that the start of the season also saw one of the worst Bushfire seasons across Australia with the Club, again showing its community mindedness, digging deep to raise funds to help out the affected regions.

If Bushfires and COVID weren't enough, construction of the Seawall in front of the Club commenced. This literally shook the club to its foundations. This threw up many challenges to the members as we worked to maintain our Patrol obligations and manage our training programs whilst losing access to the club storage areas.

I would like to thank Julie Goldner for work in continuing her role as Club Secretary, especially through the uncertainty during the coordination of the Annual Presentation Night. Thanks also to Kate Curtis for her drive to make the Presentation Night a special one. Whilst the night was a great event, we couldn't quite get the event we wanted due to COVID. I am sure we will make up for it next year.

This season Lynne Collins was recognised as Club Person of the year as a result of her ongoing efforts in raising the profile of this Club within in the Community. Lynne has spent countless hours behind the scenes working on Pink and Blue Swim, fundraising for the Bush Fire Relief, as well as the management of the Clubs commercial operation (Beachside) as a volunteer.

Finance and Commercial

The works on the Seawall have had a significant impact on our patronage this season with the noise, dust and loss of car parking, our income has been significantly impacted. Whilst the Café still returned a profit, it has resulted in an overall loss for the Club.

Compliance and Strategy

Thanks to Don Murchland for his efforts in this area. This is an important area but is also one that is hard to get the other Board Members excited about. Don has set some great ground work for the Strategy moving forward for the Club as we look forward to building on that.

Lifesaving Services, Education and Training

Credit to Graeme Cunningham for taking on both these portfolios. My vision of a Strategic Board relies on the amalgamation of these portfolios along with that of Surf Sports. However this can only happen if we can get members to fill roles in these portfolios off the Board and help the responsible Director. This is a significant change in culture and is taking some time to realise.

Facilities

The damage and interruption caused by the Seawall reconstruction has been significant. Fortunately, we are on track at this stage to see the facility demolished in early 2021. We hope the building will last that long.

Surf Sports

The Surf Sports season was a disappointment with many members feeling let down or cheated. With the bulk of the State Championships and Aussies cancelled, it was a tough lesson in resilience.

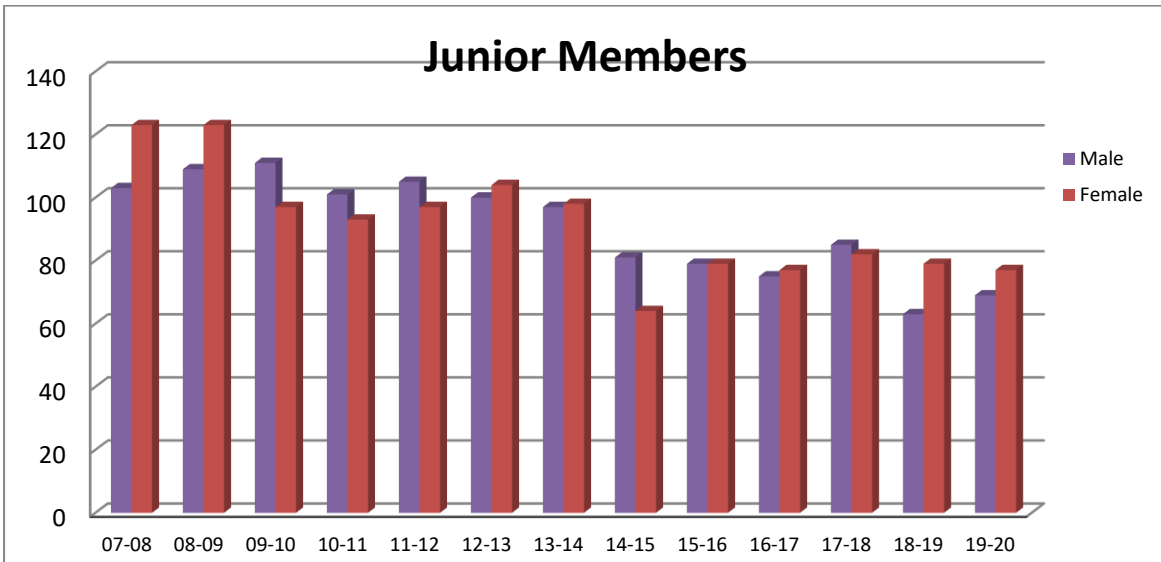
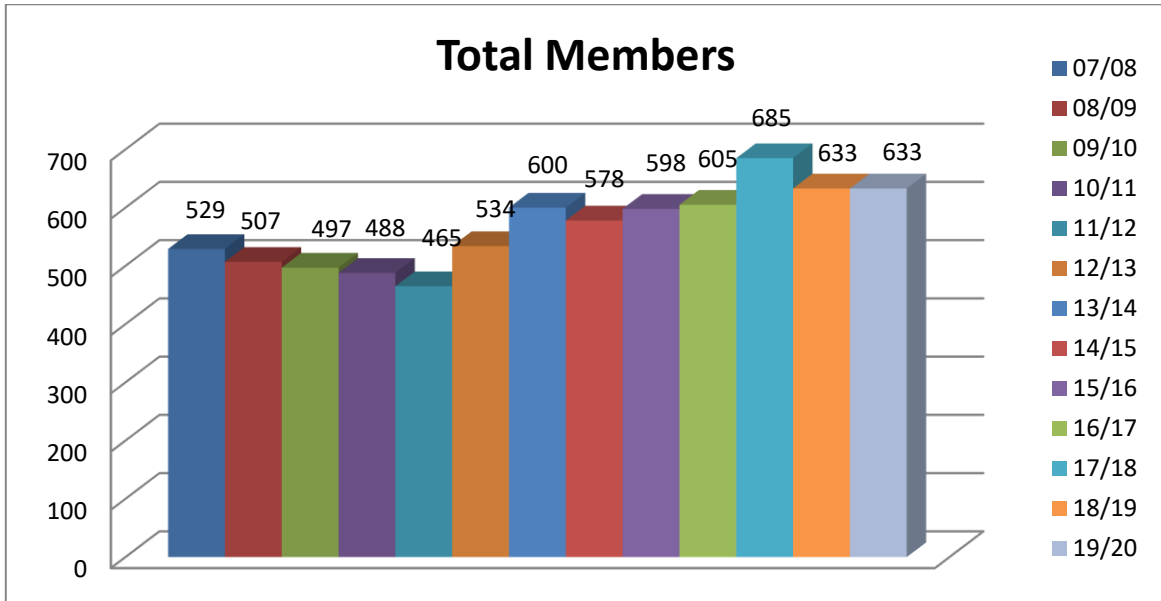

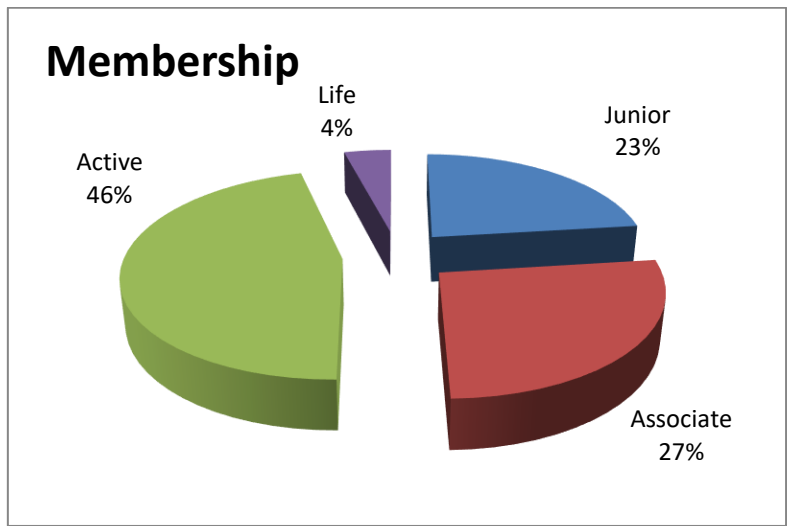

Note: Reporting of U14 membership has moved from 'Juniors' into 'Active' from 2015



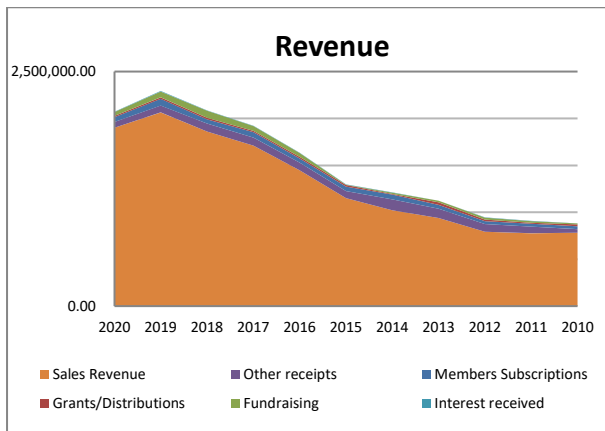
Finance

Financial income this season struggled due to a number of factors, most significantly the impact of the Seawall construction and subsequent temporary closure of the Balcony for safety reasons.

The club building fund currently sits at \$232,601.72 with this number made up largely of the Café Profit and general club Fundraising activities.

The Café showed a reduced turnover of \$1,885,522, down from \$2,044,220.65 last season generating an operating profit of \$151,776, a decrease of \$158,893 over the 2019 result. The Café closing inventory sits at \$41,4000.

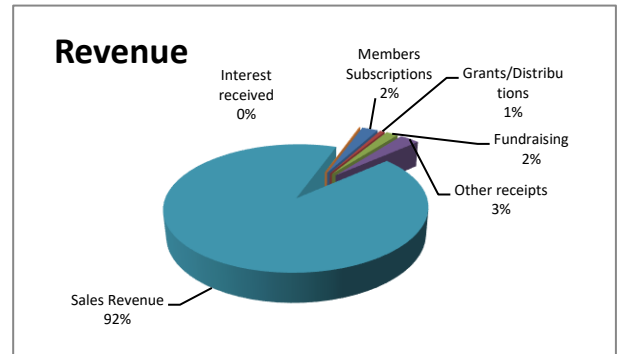
Clothing and merchandise returned a profit of \$5,022, again down on last season but still in the black. Another great result as we try to keep the margins down for our members.

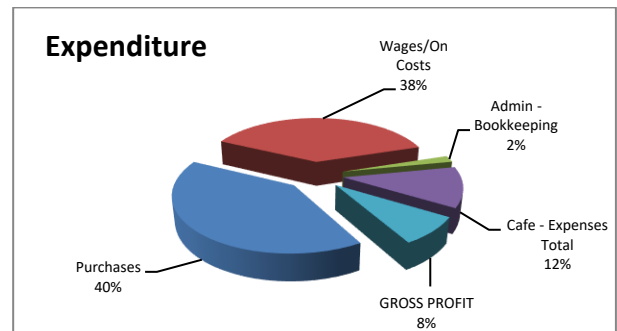

The above, and numerous other items, resulted in the "Surf Club" having Total Current Assets of \$706,459 and current liabilities of \$77,849.

This season the financials for the Pink and Blue Swim were recorded separately. However last seasons payout fell into this season and is reported in 'Fundraising Expenses – Other' of \$44,754.

Overall the season resulted in an operating loss of \$13,264, down from a profit of \$241,536 in the previous year.

Strategy and Compliance

What's it all about?

Strategy is important so members' efforts and club resources are not wasted but directed towards West Beach SLSC delivering for its members, sponsors and the beach-going public.

Strategy

In 2019 a strategic vision for the club was prepared.

The vision was the outcome of deliberation by the executive on the question of "what does success look like for West Beach Surf Lifesaving Club"?

There were over 60 responses and a clear consensus around 6 core ingredients:

1. A strong club base
2. Respected lifesaving services
3. Financial independence
4. A new club building
5. Surf sports culture and achievement
6. Leadership within the South Australian surf lifesaving movement and our local community and state.

Each outcome has been matched with the 'signs of success' which represent targets for each area. These are outlined in table below.

The next stage in the strategy development is the preparation of plans for each of 6 core areas to achieve these signs of success. These plans are to be developed with input from club members and the relevant teams will comprise the club's strategic plan.

We had quite an eventful season with the new electronic patrol logbook testing the Patrol Captains IT skills, breakages to the patrol trailer and a few major first aid emergencies as a result of our surrounding environment. Well done to all

those who helped in the emergencies and who kept their calm to help others.

West Beach continued to host and run special events this season with The Marion Long Swim and The Pink and Blue Swim both being major successes. Thanks to Don Murchland and Mike Hartas as Patrol Captains for the events and all the members that signed on for the day. Events like these could not be possible without the continuing support, collaboration and hard work from those involved.

Thank you to Sonya Salter for being the First Aid Officer this season. Her constant checking, restocking and ordering of the First Aid supplies has made our club that little bit more organised and prepared in case of an emergency.

Thank you to Bob Baker, our power craft officer, for the maintenance and upkeep of the power craft and ATV area. The ATV had to work hard this season with the transporting of equipment from the sheds to the beach and on a few occasions decided not to work while on the beach. After a new battery, new accelerator pedal and different wash down method it became a more reliable piece of Lifesaving Equipment.

Thankyou to Krista Saint John for entering patrol hours, modifying patrol entries and updating surf guard through the season. The electronic patrol log tested the Patrol Captains and required significant editing of patrols logs after each weekend.

The internal patrol auditing was done by Graeme again this season with the patrol inspection including a multiple choice tests, signals, equipment readiness inspection and a spinal resuscitation rescue utilise multiple pieces of lifesaving equipment and carrying the patient to the road for ambulance transfer. This scenario encouraged patrol groups to work as a team and it was a good test of the skills of all patrol members. It was another close year this year with the top patrol groups separated by a wrong question or incorrect signal. well done to DELTA Patrol for taking out Best Patrol 2020.

Sadly, Peter Taylor and Kylie McBain have stepped down from the Patrol Captain roles, your professionalism and commitment will be missed. Thank you from West Beach.

A Patrol Survey was instigated at the end of the 2019-20 season to determine how to improve patrols and lifesaving services. From the 276 patrolling members at West Beach SLSC 71 members completed the survey.

Survey results

Surveillance patrols during January from 9am to midday 40% of survey responses were willing to help.

Three members willing to become a patrol captains (These members are at present patrol captains so unable to increase number of patrols till more members put their hand up).

Eight members are willing to become patrol vice captains with six of these responses not presently vice captains.

Twenty members volunteered to help with the repair of rescue boards and the patrol trailer which is a positive response and should share this work more evenly.

Once again Thank you to all those who attended their patrols, helped with water cover, first aid assistance, work party and those that helped make the special events that we held such a success. Enjoy the off season and we shall see you back on the beach next season.

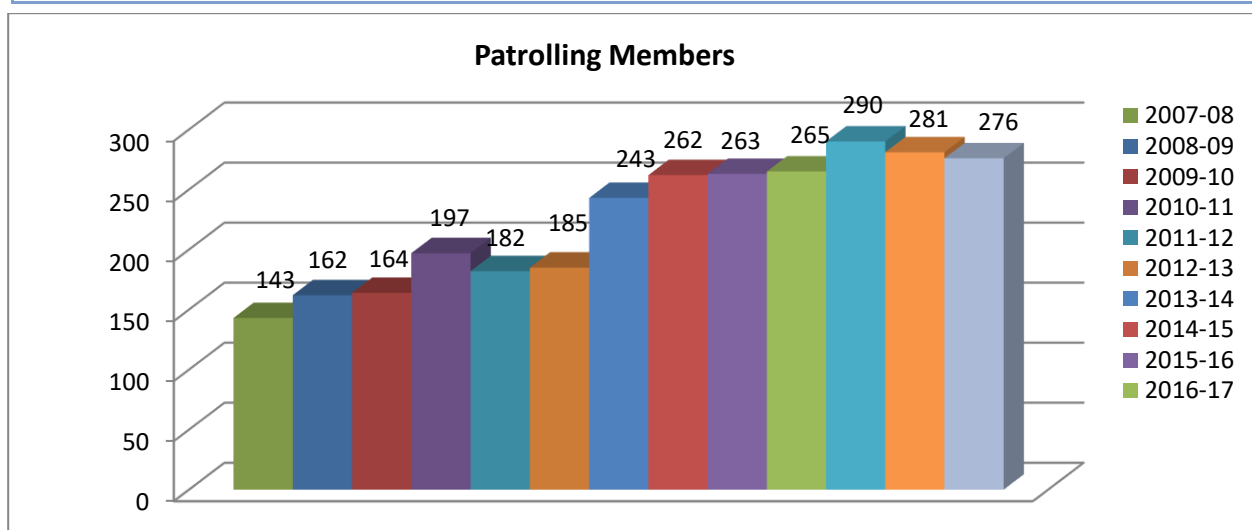

The patrol inspection consisted of four elements with maximum points of 1475 from all elements.

The inspection included

- Theory paper 30 question for 3 patrol members
- Signals practical 5 questions each for 2 patrol members
- Patrol setup including uniform, equipment and patrol area.
- Rescue scenario which included spinal carry from the water, resus, AED and oxygen then transporting the patient to the road for ambulance retrieval.

The quality of the patrols was exceptional with the top patrol group being Delta, it was another very close year with the rescues being high quality from the groups.

When you see the results, you can understand how import 5 points for a theory question, not wearing a cap or bathers can determine the result.

Well done to all patrol groups as the standard is set very high.

Education and Training

In the 2019/20 season West Beach was part of a pilot group to trial the delivery and assessment of the new national Bronze Medallion Certificate. The roll out of the pilot program was delayed due to availability of material and the setup of the bronze and SRC participants onto the online learning platform but all members in the pilot program completed the awards by the end of January. A big thank you to Sarah Kemp for handling the IT setup problems with the new online learning. As part of this pilot program the blue book will no longer be printed and is now an Online document and the SRC award is now a club-based assessment.

There were also major changes to the proficiency assessment process within Surf Lifesaving SA introducing the assessor application which enabling proficiency assessments to be entered directly into the app and updated on surf guard.

Coupled with the changes to the Bronze Medallion and proficiencies and the retirement of Denis Hay from full time assessment duties (TBA) the few active club assessors, were required to update their qualifications to a Certificate IV in Training and Assessment. These changes will require an additional (5 to 10 full days) offsite training plus a minimum of some 40 hours of course work assignments.

Congratulations to Heinrich Hofer and Graeme Cunningham for completing this skills update.

Proficiencies

With the resignation of Christine Newberry as Director of Education & Training prior to the season commencing I was asked to manage the Education and Training portfolio as part of Lifesaving services. This limited the available time for dry proficiencies till after patrols had started. We continued with splitting proficiencies into “dry” (signals / CPR / Radio) and “water” (run/swim/run and rescue) sections. This enabled

the assessors to split their time and hopefully reduce their commitment on the beach. We held several sessions at the West Beach Primary School Hall and then followed up with the water sessions once the season commenced.

These would not be possible without the hard work of our assessors and I sincerely thank them for their time, effort and commitment. Without them, we would not have active patrolling members or competitors and we are always looking for additional help in education. Please don't be afraid to come forward and assist with any training.

Matt Zuill and Owen McLeod were selected in the SA Reds Team and competed interstate for South Australia on numerous occasions. We also had a number of West Beach competitors selected in the State Team with Matt Zuill, Stella Bengler, Jayden Ellis and Jesse Ellis representing South Australia.

Swim

The swim area for the open males had the smallest amount of West Beach competitors with Matt Zuill, Jack Tierney, Bailey Hahn and Frank Martin all having consistent results throughout the carnivals and placing top 12 in the swims. Lachlan Washington and Noah Pronk achieved good results in the youth surf races.
