President's Report

The Club has survived the first year of COVID-19 and most things are back to normal. There were still interruptions this Season due to the pandemic, however all aspects of the Clubs functions returned to full or near full operation.

Construction of the Seawall and Northern Access Ramp continues with completion expected to be end of June 2021. It will be a great relief to the club once this ramp is opened, however soon after we expect another upheaval as the Club rooms are demolished in preparation for the redevelopment.

I would like to thank Julie Goldner for her continuing work in her role as Club Secretary, especially with the coordination of the Annual Presentation Night. This year we finally managed to have the Presentation Night off-site after the delays from last season. Special thanks again to Kate Curtis for her drive to make the Presentation Night happen and with over 130 members attending it was a fantastic Night.

This season we recognised the efforts of Sandra Conroy in awarding her 'Club Person of the Year' as a result of her significant assistance in all areas of the clubs operations. Sandra also gained her Trainers Certificate this season.

Finance and Commercial

The Club had a much better season this year, even with the impacts of COVID. The Government packages meant the Club was able to stay operating and even turned a profit this year. This profit would have been modest if not for the Cash Boost and Job Keeper subsidies received.

Compliance and Strategy

Tony Lake was elected to the Board this season and has continued to work on this area. Due to COVID and the delayed AGM last Season, Tony is still finding his feet.

Lifesaving Services

Christine joined the Board again and has taken on Lifesaving Services this year. Again, a very challenging year with all the COVID uncertainty, but with guidelines set by SLS SA we were able again to patrol the beaches with safety and confidence.

Of particular note this season was the amazing rescue performed by two of our youth members, Marcus Morgan and Rhys Highett. Whilst enjoying a day off and surfing at Goolwa they were called on to swim out the back and rescue a young teenager who had been swept out to sea some 600m. The rescue was performed by these two members successfully and without assistance. The association, club and your parents are all very proud of your efforts.

Education and Training

Thanks to Graeme Cunningham on taking on this role. Even with all the restrictions and barriers introduced due to COVID, we still managed to train a number of crews through various awards. Also thanks to Graeme for filling in to cover Lifesaving Services until we were able to run our AGM in October.

Facilities

Ben Lawrance joined the Board at the last AGM and has quickly found his place in the Facilities Portfolio. Ben has a huge task ahead of him as we move into the transition to the new Club Development.

Youth Development

Thanks to Anthony Thomas for his continued work in this Portfolio. His efforts are now recognised with the increase in Junior members in the Nipper program and the quality of lifesavers moving into the Senior Club.







Note: Reporting of U14 membership has moved from 'Juniors' into 'Active' from 2015




Finance

Financial income for the 2020/2021 season was exceptionally high due to good management and Covid Job Seeker and stimulus packages of \$477,500.

The club building fund currently sits at \$168,710.42.


The Café showed a turnover this year of \$2,202,319 up on \$1,885,522 from last year with growth of \$316,796, generating an operating profit of \$58,284.97, a decrease of \$93,491 on the 2019/2020 result. The profit number is considerably down against the turnover as the Job Keeper Payments of \$375,00 are not shown in the Cafe Revenue as they came in under other income, however our Job Keeper Wages were paid out of the Cafés Staff Costs.

Entire Club Revenue this season was \$2,804,920.


The Café closing inventory sits at \$47,854.

Clothing and merchandise returned a loss of \$4,594. This appears to be a combination of timing of payment and receipt of stock as well as increased purchase prices during COVID and the Club running this at very small profit margins for members.

Total cash on hand 2020/2021 is \$1,020,792, an increase of \$434,532 over 2019/2020 season.

The above, and numerous other items, resulted in the "Surf Club" having Total Current Assets of \$1,134,889 and current liabilities of \$105,430

Overall the season resulted in an operating profit of \$348,947 an increase of \$362,211 over the previous year.

Facilities

This last year has brought with it its challenges. Mainly because of the deteriorating condition of our main building and not knowing whether to fix issues for the short term or the long term. Myself and our core maintenance team, Bob, Lauren and Peter L, together with a large number of contractors continue to keep the Club and Beachside safe and serviceable for volunteers, staff and customers.

As well as ongoing maintenance the focus has been on the transition of the Club to Beachside and back. This activity has been frustrated due to the fluidity of the project management system. As this year is almost halfway through the focal point of transition is coming more and more into focus. There has been a small number of meetings involving Club stakeholders to measure and assess their requirements during and after transition. Some of the considerations are listed below

- Need to identify what we need to take
- If we don't want it Sell it or leave it

 - How Big Bang or staged process? This will depend on timelines established between closing the Surf Club and Demolition.
- Commercial
 - Liquor Licence transfer
 - What will be needed is dependent on the Redline redefinition
 - Toilet upgrade rear of Beachside.
 - New doorway from Beachside toilets to rear carpark
 - o Install Beer System
 - Build office Cool room or Container
 - Uniform Shop

- Life Saving
 - What is needed close to the Beach?
 - First aid, Patrol room, what do we do with the Radio System?
 - What needs to be stored in the Shed?
 - What do you need access to only weekly?
 - What don't you need?
 - Where is acceptable for an IRB to be stored? 1 or 2?
- Education
 - Approach Surf Life for use of their facilities for training for the period of Club construction.
 - What do you need?
- Surf Sports
 - Is there anything you need close to the beach?
 - Is the shed close enough?
 - What do you need to transport equipment?
- Nippers
 - Trailer storage.
 - Board trailer how many boards?
 - Location for Saturday Mornings Drive way to Beachside?
 - What else do you need?
- Boats
 - Is it possible they can be stored away from the shed to free up space in the shed?
- What access do we need for a Gym?
 - Possible club membership of a gym.
 - Set up the rubber floor inside the shed
 Space permitting?

Commercial Operations

Wow, what a year!

On March 23rd we got shut down with the first of about 26 different constantly changing COVID restrictions, we opened up again about half way through April as a 'Mini Market'; the idea was to try and sell all our stock (convert it to dollars instead of waste) as we had no idea how long the restrictions would last. I thought this would also restore some confidence in life with our members and locals. As everything happened so quickly, we had a lot of freshly tapped kegs and instead of wasting them, we sold take away carafes which everyone loved! We sold all our dry store, kegs, wine bottles, soft drink and the odd roll or two of jumbo toilet rolls – all income we wouldn't have had otherwise.

We could tell from the general comments everyone was struggling, so we made up some take away food and sold it fresh and frozen and to our delight we couldn't keep up! As it was very difficult to get supplies, this is how we operated for about 3 months. By June 13th we could, under COVID restrictions, operate with 20 diners and we had these restrictions on and off until September. Through this period we fluctuated as the rules and consumer confidence did.

Another 2020 hurdle we unexpectedly faced was the closing of our balcony for about 6 months due to damage caused by the building of the rock wall; the balcony was condemned by Charles Sturt Council in early March, and only able to be reopened, thankfully with warmer months approaching, after the approval of council engineers following an inspection.

During this entire period, if we didn't have JobKeeper we couldn't have operated without suffering huge losses that we might not of recovered from for a long time. Had JobKeeper not been in place, we likely would have only been able to open from September onwards in a very limited capacity following Covid restrictions. As well as club income, we would have had all of our wonderful team without work or an income, further impacting our local community. On an incredibly positive note, congratulations to Kate and her team on an incredible job! Some spent hours above and beyond any JobKeeper payment and given the constant movement of the Covid restrictions, the staff worked really well and happily supported all the different phases we went through constantly.

All of the hard work in keeping the club functioning, and keeping a community feel has paid off for us, we have had magnificent feedback constantly and our patronage has grown through this period. It is hard to believe that we only put the grass on the slab in 2015; the growth and feedback we have had from functions and entertainment, to daily use, has grown exponentially, especially when you consider the last 3 years we have had a rock wall and now a path constantly being built around us and causing major disruption to patronage.

Lifesaving, is the real reason why we are all here. It is the reason why we are part of the club and the club isn't just the West Beach Surf Club, it's the surf lifesaving club. We become lifesavers and we encourage our children to become lifesavers because the club exists to save lives, create great Australians, and build better communities. We all want to feel safe in the water and what better way, than to embrace a community that provides us with surf skills that we can use, develop, and grow, in all facets of our lives – whether we are at work or home.

To be a good lifesaver, we need to be proficient, we need to train, and we need to maintain these skills. We need to be rescue ready. We can learn new skills through education, we can maintain our skills through training, and we can better our skills by competing and constant practice. Surf Sports is a really obvious way of acknowledging the achievements of a lifesaver, and for that competition, you are competing to win a medal or to achieve a goal and even if you come last, you are still winning because you know that when you are faced with a situation where you may be needed, you have the skills you can use that may save a life.

Despite the warnings, the education, the advancements in technology and techniques people still drown in our waters in unacceptably high numbers. We all wish to stop this, but sadly, we can't always be in the "place" at the time our skills may be needed.

There is no competition for real rescues. A real rescue happens when you are not expecting it – it happens when you may be required to draw on your skills and overcome your fears, to help save a life. In January this year, Marcus Morgan, and Rhys Highett were in the right place. There seemed to be little hesitation by either of them,

to do what many of us would feel scared and not be capable of doing. They then swam a casual 600 metres through the Goolwa shore break to find a boy, that had been swept out to sea. Despite the intense pressure and panic of all those around them, using their swimming abilities, they swam out, found him barely able to keep his head above water and they both swam him back to shore.

Together Marcus and Rhys have saved a life. They did this with barely a thought for themselves with little or no hesitation and as a club we would like to say congratulations for what will become a story that they both will relive and re-tell and will look back with pride and amazement at maturity they showed, the skills they displayed and the realisation that they kept a someone safe to enjoy a full life. That is truly extraordinary.

The 2020 / 2021 Season has been another season where you, our members showed commitment, acceptance of change - both in our world and in the club and the way we operate, and within lifesaving, we witnessed some brave rescues and we saw calmness in times of need. What a year it has been!

The season flowed smoothly with the continuation of our patrol equipment being accessed from shipping containers and there were relatively few issues with this method of operation.

Our patrol captains and their Vice Captains, IRB Drivers and crew, First Aiders, ART operators, exemplify W.E.S.T B.E.A.C.H. Together, our members make up our Surf Life Saving Club and together we make this place, great.

At the start of the season, we saw our members travelling to the APY Lands to teach remote communities about safety around the water, during the season, they teach at Vacswim around the State and they completed over 91 patrols for the season, (not including external events). We volunteer countless hours via SurfCom, provided 16 rosters for Saturday Water Cover totalling over 500 hours, and in total, our patrolling members completed 5,512.34 hours of club patrol. This season, we were relatively unscathed with major and minor incidents, though we did have a sting ray attack a member during training, resulting in severe pain, 6 stiches, a scar for life and a full recovery!

The now not new app, worked well, still posing a challenge for some, but making that part of the role, much easier to manage. This still needs some work, but it is getting there!

I would like to acknowledge the hard work and dedication of our Patrol Captains assisted ably by their Vice Captains. Running a patrol takes a team and what a team we have. Thank you to those who will be stepping down this season, you have done a great job and we wish you all the best for the future.

West Beach continued to host and run special events this season with much success. We continued to provide support to schools and community groups who required water cover, lifeguards and surf education – thank you to all her assisted.

Thank you to those members who fulfilled roles throughout the season.



Swim, Board, Ski and Beach Report Swim

The swim area has become increasingly stronger with a new wave of young competitors showing their dedication to the squad through their commitment to the 5am grind in the pool. The gap between Open competitors and the youth has not been so small in an area in many years, indicating a bright future for the Surf Club and the sport. The swim area makes up a large portion of events at State Titles which is why the upcoming crew is so vital to the team. In the Opens, Georgia Zuill placed second in the Female Belt Race with Leah Jones finishing fifth and Matt Zuill placing third in the Male Surf Race. The open females showed their strength in the swim area, taking out the Rescue Tube Rescue and placing second in the Surf Teams, with the second teams finishing fourth in each event.

As expected the Youth age groups dominated in the swim discipline. The Under 14s saw Edie Benger, Lucy Beaumont and Zara Trim finish first, third and fifth in the Female Surf Race. In the Under 15s the Males were the stand out competitors taking out 5 of the top 10 positions, with Felix Atanackovic finishing sixth, Noah Pronk in third and Lochie Washington – this seasons Swim Area Award winner – placing second. Bringing the Under 14 and 15 age groups together for Surf Teams resulted in a Gold for the Males and a Silver for the Females.

The Swim Area is often a good indicator of the level of dedication of the team. It is no easy feat to complete the training required to compete at this level and it would not be possible without the support of the squad, coaches – both surf and pool – and parents. It is great to see the consistent commitment to training throughout the squad and we look forward to what is to come.

Board

The board area has had another outstanding season, again one of our club's greatest strengths. Many of our competitors showed strong commitment and dedication from winter training right through to the peak of the season. There were many great results from carnivals and interstate events, which lead to fantastic results at state titles.

Although the opens were unable to execute their individual board races at State Titles, they showed their strength and depth by taking out both the Open Female and Open Male Board Relays, with the female B team finishing 4th. The opens were also able to demonstrate their board paddling skills throughout a number of relays, claiming a number of medals. In the senior age groups Billy Trim and Georgia Materne both finished sixth in their Under 17 Board Races and Stella Benger finishing fourth in the Under 19 Female Board Race.

The stand outs in the board area this season were the youth competitors. In the Under 14s age group, the female board race was taken out by Edie Benger with Zara Trim finishing third, while Aiden placed second in the male board final. The Under 15s finished with a number of top six placings, including Kelsey Lawson and Noah Pronk each finishing sixth, Daisy Trim finishing fifth, Lochie Washington finishing third and Felix Atanackovic – this seasons Board Area Award winner – taking out the gold. Ski

The ski section for many years has been one of our areas of strength. This season we had a smaller group of paddlers out at training but still had lots of improvements and many good results. State titles was a highlight with many clubs improving in their ski areas and some tough competition.
