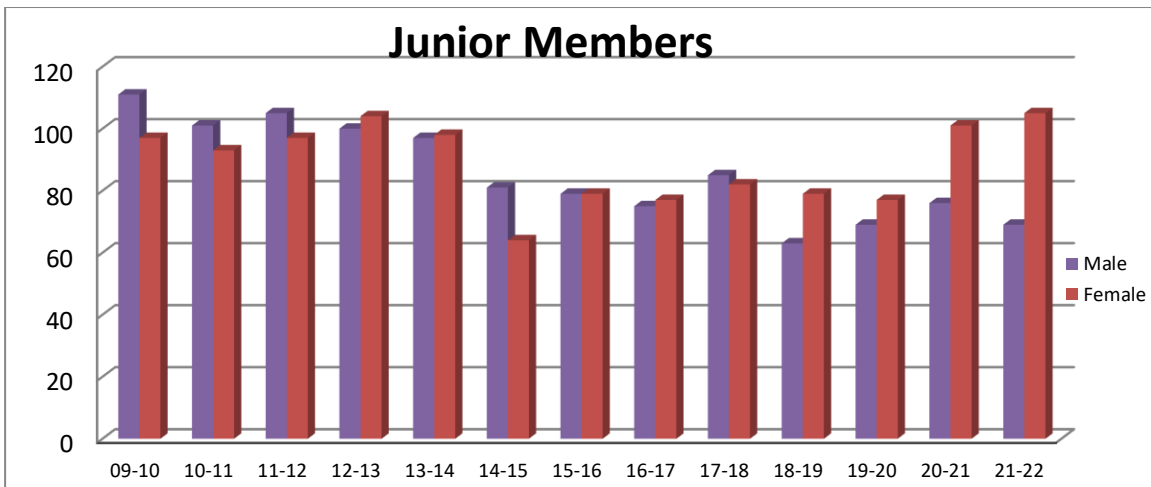
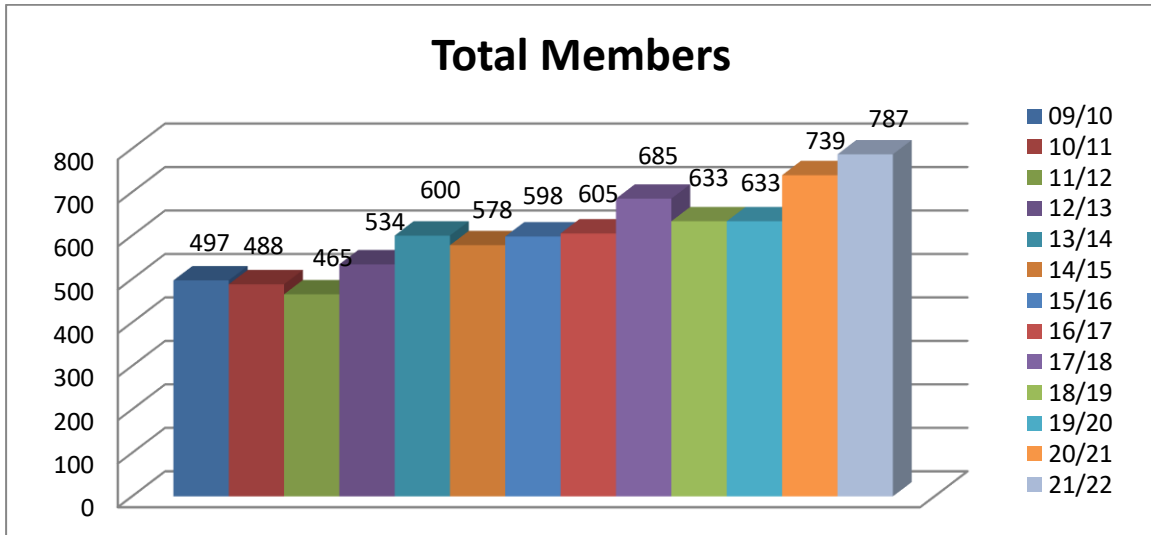

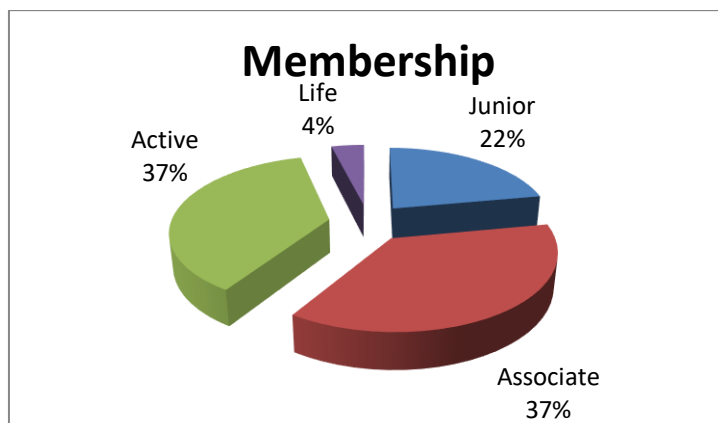

Note: Reporting of U14 membership has moved from 'Juniors' into 'Active' from 2015

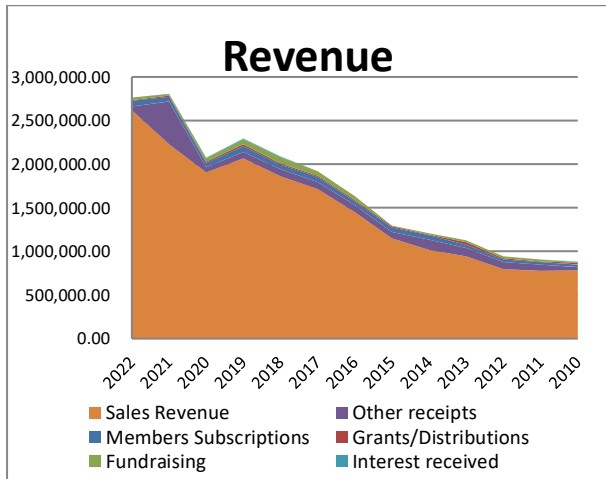


Finance

Financial income for the 2021/2022 season was down slightly on last year as the Government Grants and Job Keeper payments from COVID ceased. With a lot of cost management by the staff we were able to keep the cost of goods in check to return another great profit.

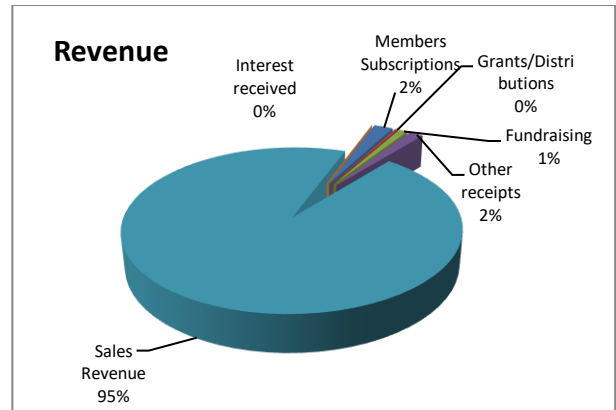
The Café showed a turnover this year of \$2,588,942, up on \$2,202,319 from last year with growth of over \$380,000, generating an operating profit of \$538,693 compared to \$53,690 last year.

Breakdown of income

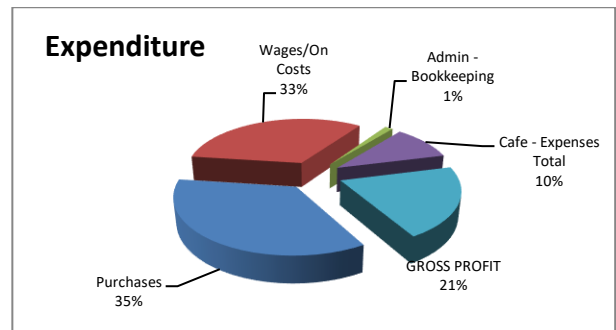

Clothing and merchandise returned a profit of \$4,755, a great result in an area where we try to keep members costs to a minimum.

Total cash on hand at 30th March 2022 was \$1,301,175.31, an increase of around \$280,000 over 2019/2020 season.

Overall the season resulted in an operating profit of \$224,830 after taking in to account expenses of \$77,000 in new assets and \$202,788 in Redevelopment costs.

Facilities

Well, the end of another year as Bob's apprentice with the Surf Club. If I received a dollar for each time somebody said it only has to last 3 months, I would be rich man.

Surf Club

Ongoing maintenance at the club upstairs and downstairs is testament to the fact we need a new building. We have used enough zip ties, duct tape and silicone to keep Bunnings alive for a couple of years. The maintenance upstairs this last year has been mainly keeping the systems going for the least amount of cost. There have been times where the option to keep a piece of equipment going outweighed the cost of purchasing new. We have always been mindful of what is purchased new, is able to be used at Beachside or the new club.

Most of the equipment in the kitchen is past its end of life. Kate and the chefs have done a wonderful job keeping the kitchen going under sometimes difficult circumstances. Some of the equipment will be moved to Beachside and Beachside will become the equipment's final resting place.

The bar systems are in good condition, they will be moved with us or sold later. Tables chairs, cupboards, heaters, fans, lights, audio visual equipment, will all be assessed for future use, sale or dumping.

Our Cool Room and Freezer are being assessed for movement to Beachside or sale. We are working on a cost benefit as you read this.

As you all know we moved the gym to its new location at the oval. All the feedback has been good. It freed up downstairs to move some stuff around and take the pressure of the last months of the patrol season. We have had several broken and leaking pipes downstairs which we have managed to get under control in a timely manner.

The only real damage was when the ice making machine on the deck leaked into the female dressing rooms and flooded the whole area. This was a very interesting leak as it had us completely confused about where the water was coming from. Bob, myself and Norm worked it out. Electricity downstairs in an issue and will be until the club is demolished. Electricians, distributors, contractors have all been and had a look and there is no immediate fix, other than to say it is safe.

There were no major OH+S issues this last year. I like to think of it as good management rather than good luck.

Beachside

Maintenance issues at Beachside are fixed with a longer term in mind. No major expenses. Kitchen and bar equipment is average and will see us into the new club. Beachside is, of course, the focus of the transition from old club to new club. There will be the movement of some equipment from the old club to the new club. We are trying not to waste anything.

Commercial Operations

Club

This year was another tough year with Covid restricting numbers then wiping staff out and losing functions, floods and fuel costs increasing all cost of goods up to 25% this year on top of the increase of 15 to 20% last year.

Kate, Damien and all duty managers have kept a tight control on cost of goods, wage percentages and general running expenses, thank you to all.

Our sales for food and beverage this year were \$2,589,815 which is \$336,808 higher than the previous year (with the removal of any Job Keeper) which is a 14.95% increase of sales.

We have dropped our food cost by 4.61% over a very hard period. A lot of this is due to the relentless chasing of best deals by our Chef Joshi.

At the same time our beverage costs have also been dropped by 1.3% due to some hard work by Kate and Damien in purchases and wastage. They also dropped our wage percentage by around 4% lowering it to 32.56%. This was achieved by weekly looking and working the rosters with the previous weeks percentages at hand.

Approximately 18% of all sales had a member discount meaning around 82% of all sales are made by the general community, which allows us to run the discounted sales which are at the following cost percentage food 43.14% beverage 35.63%.

Beachside

Beachside started to fire up nicely and then we had to shut for Covid rules making it impossible to break even, then we ran out of staff due to the ISO rules (we thought it better to leave all staff at the club and shut Beachside).

I would like to thank Lynne Collins for all the work she has voluntarily put into all the functions at

Beachside. I'm pretty sure she has a 100% sales record on any one she met with.

We lost a lot of functions when Covid rules changed what customers were allowed to do, of which about 50% rebooked at another date. Functions have been the difference between profit and loss at Beachside.

Clothing

Once again a great year, thank you very much Rachel Bell and your magnificent team. Sales are up by around \$5,000 which is most likely why you see WBSLSC tops through the whole neighbourhood (great branding) at the time of writing this I believe clothing profit is about \$6,400 (held in stock).

Going Forward

I think it's important to put this line in for history, to be able to reflect on where and what we are trying to achieve with Beachside over the next 18 or so months. The idea of Beachside is for our club to have a base whilst our new club is rebuilt, this will enable us to socialise together and keep our core ethos strong, whilst keeping our culture alive.

As a club it will also allow us to go into a newly built clubroom with a strong hospitality team and hopefully make a little revenue on the journey. This is all of course up to you as the members to show your support of Beachside with you patronising the venue.

So please be part of the West Beach Surf Life Saving Club at Beachside during our rebuild. We need everyone's support.

Pink & Blue Swim/Walk

What a memorable day!

Mother nature turned it on and gave us a glorious day with the sun shining, a beautiful beach on show and a lovely warm temperature for our 10th annual West Beach Surf Lifesaving Club cancer fund raiser

The Pink and Blue team are proud to announce the final total of proceeds raised from the 2022 event was **\$92,100**. That's over **\$400,000** raised from the last 10 Pink and Blue events! We are very keen to nudge the half a million dollar mark next year.

The proceeds this year were split equally with \$46,050 given to the St Andrews Hospital Breast Care Unit and the other \$46,050 to the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia.

We are so proud of how the West Beach Surf Lifesaving Club members rally around this great cause and work tirelessly to ensure a successful event. The day is filled with color, laughter and music, throughout our tribute area, marquees, banners, water cover and the amazing singers from Immanuel College with a backdrop of Pink and Blue filtering all over the area

With over **940 participants in 2022, and a social media reach of over 50,000** the event is truly capturing people's hearts in our fight against cancer.

This year the event was awarded the 'South Australia's Community Event' of the year and is now recognised as a major event in Adelaide.

I have included below the commentary that accompanied the award received at Government House.

'South Australia's Community Event of the Year 2022

West Beach Surf Life Saving Club's Annual Pink and Blue Swim/Walk (City of Charles Sturt)

With thousands of Australians dying of breast and prostate cancer each year an imaginative pink and blue outdoor fundraiser has people lining up in their hundreds to take part. As a colourful outdoor charity event that takes place on water and on land at West Beach every Summer, the aim of the annual 'West Beach Surf Life Saving Club's Pink & Blue Swim or Walk' is to raise money to improve treatment and outcomes for people suffering from breast and prostate cancers. It consists of family and pet-friendly walks of 2kms and swims over 200m, 500m or 1km distances. 100 per cent of the entry fee goes to the St Andrews Hospital Breast Care Unit and the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia. The event was first staged in 2013 by the West Beach Surf Life Saving Club's volunteers. It attracted 80 participants. It has now evolved to include a walk (making it more inclusive) and has generated more than \$310,000 since its inception. In 2021 more than 860 people took part with donations totalling \$61,000'.

We look forward to seeing everyone at next year's Pink and Blue Swim/walk on Saturday 11th February 2023 and thank everyone for their continued support

West Beach SLSC has three Community programs running at present



CALD swim program in partnership with I Swim Immanuel with over 18 participants learning how to swim run by Peter Taylor, Carol and Kevin Richardson.

This program is to teach swimming and lifesaving skills with participants working towards SLSA advanced resuscitation certificate and bronze medallion. West beach not only provides trainers for these programs but covers the financial cost. Over the winter months we focused on new members training in First Aid and Advanced Resuscitation Techniques with 18 CALD members achieving there ARTC Certificate.



In conjunction with (MACSA) Muslim Australian Connection we ran two beach awareness days with over 200 people attending both days where the learn water safety and catch waves on boards



I Can Jump Puddles beach day for children and adults with disabilities was also run with John McArthur provide support, picking up the beach access chairs and ramp from Henley and helped run activities for NDIS beach day

Thanks to Peter Taylor and John McArthur for the great work in this area.

Strategy and Compliance

Compliance, strategy, and governance are hugely complex areas involving many facets of the law, both State and Federally and navigation in a volunteer organisations is often difficult. We are a member of Clubs SA Clubs SA which is the official industry body representing the interests of licensed Clubs in this State. Clubs SA's major platform has been to effect change to government legislation to enable Clubs to become more self-sufficient over the long term, and to provide a recognised infrastructure for the active support and promotion of sport and community events across the Club industry.

As a Club, we adhere to legislation such as:

- Associations Incorporation Act 1985
- Liquor Licensing Act 1997
- Liquor Licensing Act 1997 General Code of Practice
- Liquor Licensing (General) Regulations 2012
- Fair Work Act 2009
- Work Health & Safety Act (SA) 2012
- Equal Opportunity Act 1984
- Food Act 2001
- Tobacco and E-Cigarette Products Act 1997
- Registered and Licensed Clubs Award 2010

We manage and need to comply with the Children Protection Act 1993 and follow the requirements regarding Working with Children Checks which is managed by the Department of Human Services.

Working With Children Check

- *People working or volunteering with children in South Australia must, by law, have a Working with Children Check.*
- *A Working with Children Check is an assessment of whether a person poses an unacceptable risk to children. As part of the process, the Screening Unit will look at criminal history, child protection information and other information.*

- *Employees or volunteers will need to get a Working with Children Check if:*
 - *you work with children on more than 7 days (whether consecutive or not) in a calendar year; or*
 - *your child-related work involves close personal contact with children with disability.*
- *Clubs and associations that provide services or activities and have:*
 - *a significant membership of children, or a significant involvement by children*
 - *are doing child-related work.*

We are affiliated with Surf Life Saving South Australia and adopt the policies of our National Body, Surf Life Saving Australia.

Strategy - A strategic planning process

Our building re-development is exciting and the biggest project we as club volunteers will participate in as members and volunteers at the West Beach Surf Life Saving Club. The aim of a strategic plan is to focus an organisation's vision and priorities in response to a changing environment and to ensure that all members of the organisation are working toward the same goals. Strategic management harnesses an organisation's full potential by considering daily operational decisions in the context of the strategic plan. Strategic management is a task for the whole organisation all the time. It is a way of thinking and a guide to action, and it should govern the behaviour of everybody concerned. It enables organisations to think through and document what they are doing, for whom they are doing it, and why they are doing it.

The Board has committed to undertaking this process and the members will be invited to participate as key stakeholders. We want to see a successful strategic planning process that is genuinely inclusive, involving all its stakeholders -

paid and volunteer staff, the board, and the community. We have engaged the services of an expert to guide us through this process as we move towards our re-build and as we continue to develop our core areas of:

- A strong club base
- Respected lifesaving services
- Financial independence
- A new club building and the facilities and equipment
- A culture and record of achievement in Surf Sports
- A leader within the surf lifesaving movement and its community

Compliance

Congratulations to Kilo Patrol best patrol group for the 2021/22 Season.

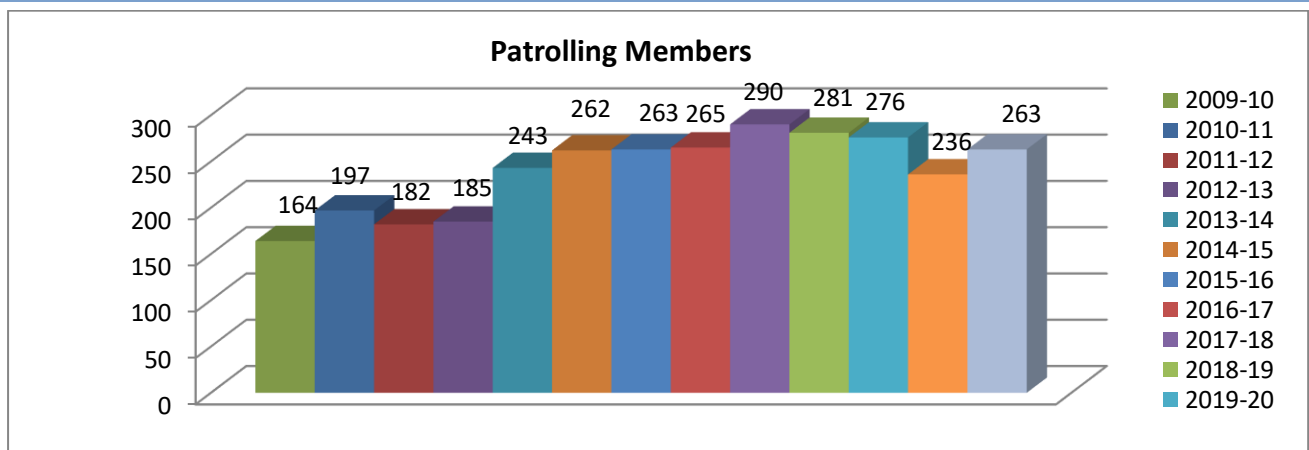

West Beach came away with three silvers to Stella, Georgia, and Matt, while Millie and Edie just missed out on podium positions. Aiden showed his strength taking out his age group, but being the best in the state wasn't enough so one month later he travelled over to the Gold Coast where he took out the National U15 2km Championship.

The 2x1km relay was the next event for West Beach to show our strength in the distance running by entering eight teams across the age groups and opens with every team placing in the top 6 including a bronze to Aiden and Max in U15s, a bronze to Millie and Stella in U19s, a silver to Georgia and Sophie in opens, and Aiden backing up in opens to take home the gold with Matt. Masters

seasoned masters competitors (Greg & Steve Perry, David Juniper & Norm Collins). Greg, Steve and Barney also help out with ski coaching across the year, which not only helps the masters group, but WB in general. A big thank you to all.

Although we don't officially give out a most improved award, if we did, this year it would go to Hernan Martel. Anyone who went to any training sessions this year (board, swim, ski, run) would have seen Hernan there, always giving his best. He pushed himself well out of his comfort zone, and in doing so, he inspired many of the rest of us. Particularly Sandy, who was his regular side-kick, and Leila, who was so impressed with his determination in high winds that she pushed herself into those conditions also.

Lifesaving

The Lifesaving area of competition has always been an area of work in progress for the WB surf club. This includes RnR, First Aid, Champion Patrol and Champion Lifesaver.

In the U15 2person age group Hayley stepped into team up with Alexander after his teammate was ruled out due to Covid, but still managed to win a Bronze. Lily and Ruby Thomas finished 2nd in their final year of the RnR competition after 8 seasons. Over the years the girls have medalled 7 of the 8 times with 4 of those being Gold.
