# **President's Report**

2013-2014 was highlighted by the record breaking numbers in membership, Pink Swim participants and Nipperthon participants. Membership grew to over 600 members this season, almost 90 more than our previous high of 526 in 2008-2009. In the last few years, the membership numbers had reached a plateau so it was great to see it once again grow. With the Club Re-development getting closer, the signs are there for West Beach to continue to grow in membership and participation across all the areas of Surf Lifesaving. The Pink Swim, only the second time we have run it, raised in excess of \$10,000 for the National Breast Cancer Foundation, whilst Nipperthon continued to attract more and more kids.

I look forward to our continuing partnership with these members of government at all levels.

Surf Lifesaving is now a year-round activity with some surf sports just starting their winter season whilst it only seems like yesterday we were celebrating our achievements over the summer period. The West Beach Surf Lifesaving Club has many events organised for the coming year and I hope to see all our members as well as more new ones enjoying what we provide in the coming months.

#### **Secretary**

Sarah Price took on the role of Secretary as well as Director Member Services this Season due to a vacancy in that role. Sarah was assisted later in the season by Melissa Davis-Bishop when she was appointed by the Board as a Director. As well as organising the Annual Presentation Night, which was again a great success, Melissa was also responsible for the preparation of this Annual Report. This is a huge task and I thank her for her efforts.

#### **Member Services**

Sarah Price returned to the Board this year in this portfolio following some time off for the birth of her first clubbie to suddenly find out she was expecting a second one. This set the scene for the Season with two other Sarah's (Goodwin and Tinkham) also announcing news of the 'next wave'.

As in recent years, the Annual Dinner and Presentation Night was held at the Club. The format was similar to last Season and seems to be working well. A great time was had by all. Thanks to Kevin Richardson for taking on the MC role and keeping everyone on track. Thanks to Sarah and Melissa for their work behind the scenes and Trophy Selections.

As mentioned, the Club ran its second Annual Pink Swim to raise money and awareness for Breast Cancer. This year the Pink Swim was a huge success and very well attended with Federal and State politicians actively involved. The total raised was in excess of \$10,000, significantly increased from our inaugural event last season coming in at \$957.75. This event has again been set on the State Surf Lifesaving Calendar.

#### **Finance**

The Club's financial position has continued to improve significantly this Season. Thanks to David Afford for his efforts in this area. This Season saw the introduction of the Building Fund as a part of our membership fee structure. The income from this was just over \$3,000. This money is set aside and can only be used in the re-development of our new facilities. The Board voted at its last meeting to put in \$30,000 of our reserves into this building fund as well.

#### **Facilities**



Paul Rafanelli was the appointed Director for this portfolio. Thanks to Paul for all his work in this area. Maintenance continues on the existing facility to keep it in a respectable state. We will wind down any improvements on the current facility with our focus now shifting to the re-development of our Club. Thanks to Kevin Richardson and the Building committee of Stephen Perry and Paul Rafanelli for all their work to date. It will be a process and with 2 to 3 years to go, there is a lot more to be done.

The Cafe continued to be one of our major income streams and has recorded some good results once again. After a number of attempts to get the structure and balance right, I believe we have a viable commercial model that will assist us in the future to secure any necessary funding for the redevelopment. Thankyou to Brian and Kate for their long hours and patience. Thankyou to all the Cafe Staff.

#### **Lifesaving Services**

The Club once again provided all its Lifesaving Services obligations without any breaches as well as performing extremely well in the Patrol Efficiency Tests performed during the Season. This is a credit to the standard of our volunteer members who sign on to Patrol.

Thanks to Sarah Tinkham for managing this portfolio again this season. It is a major undertaking to try and plan and schedule so many volunteers for Patrols and to ensure the balance of members needs with the contractual obligations to State Centre.

Congratulations to Sarah on the pending arrival of her new baby twins – Good Luck!!

#### **Training and Education**

Graeme Cunningham took on this portfolio this Season. This are ran very smoothly once again and it was great to be able to get so many members proficient. This is a huge effort for Graeme and his team of Assessors as they selfishly give their time over numerous weekends to ensure each of us can become proficient. As Club members we all need to be more thoughtful of them and ensure we complete our proficiencies early and in one session, rather than coming back week after week waiting for the tide to be right or the cans to be set a bit closer.


Tracy Ellis did another great job with the uniform shop. This is a huge responsibility and making yourself available every Saturday was a big commitment.

It's been another big year from our café which has seen revenue grow continually, breaking through the \$1,000,000 barrier. What an outstanding effort from our hard working staff and a big thankyou to our loyal patrons. Many new initiatives have occurred throughout the year including music on Sunday afternoons followed by dinners throughout the summer holidays, generating more people through the club.

The club held a number of large functions including AFL grand final day, New Year's Eve party and the Pink breast cancer swim to name a few. Having good facilities allows us to entertain and has become a place of choice when deciding on a top venue to hold a function.

Other improvements throughout the club have included

- Shipping containers to help storage issues
- Data projector replaced by 70 inch TV
- Roller blinds and LED lighting installed on the pergola
- Outside garden on the southern side of club
- Signage on the front of club
- Floodlights on the balcony facing the sea
- Pathway to the beach on the northern side

An important cost reduction strategy in installing solar panels on top our pergola will drastically reduce our electricity bill which has been as high as \$27,000 over previous years.

A big thank you to the people who have helped out with their time, completing maintenance tasks and keeping the club facilities in a workable and safe state. If anyone is interested in assisting, please contact me as maintenance can be a huge cost.

Kevin Richardson is working tirelessly on our redevelopment, accumulating many hours of work with the development of plans to continue moving forward. Kevin will present to the

members what has evolved to date and a time line in reaching our goals.

One of the biggest hurdles we faced this year was the damage and erosion of our beach in October 2013. Plenty of discussions have taken place with work finally commencing in March on the beach front with anticipation that the sand pumping will solve some of the issues. Understandably we are in need of a permanent solution, or our beach will always be under constant threat.



Our top room manager over the last two years, Brian Durack made a decision to resign from his position to pursue other interests and we wish him the best for the future.

Once again, a huge thank you to the staff for their efforts over the past year, and the ongoing support received from the board and members to produce a very successful year for the Club.

In the last twelve months the "Building the Future" Committee has been extremely active.



- Initial concept plans completed
- Architect and surveyor engaged
- Survey completed
- · Schedule and requirements finalised
- An offsite storage facility proposal and plan completed

We have been working closely with the facilities management group of Surf Lifesaving SA to ensure funding is available from Emergency Services.

In the next few months we begin formal discussions with Surf Life Saving SA, the City of Charles Sturt and informal discussions with Coastal Protection.



I am pleased to report the 2013/14 season has again been rewarding in both the competition arena and in the education of our young Lifesavers. One of our high points this year was the number of U14s and eligible U13s who attained their Surf Rescue Certificate as well as the large group of under 9s that continued on from Little Beachies with many of them competing at this year's carnivals






At the beginning of the season, we set goals and objectives for West Beach during the competition season. An athlete's handbook was produced containing all information for the athletes for the season. We will rely more heavily on the handbook for providing information into the future.
